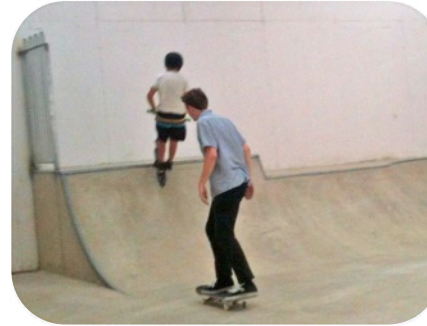
MY SIX PRIORITIES ARE ...
